- Lead Acid Batteries
- Dry Cell
- Lithium
- Ni-Cad
- Recyclable

## **Oxidizers**

- Pool Chemicals
- Spa Chemicals
- Bleaches
- Hydrogen Peroxide
- Ammonium Nitrate Fertilizer

## **Mercury**

- Free-Liquid
- Thermostats
- Thermometers
- Any device containing mercury
- Mercurichrome

## **Corrosives**

- Drain Cleaners
- Toilet Bowl Cleaners
- Muriatic Acid
- Deck Wash
- Vinegar
- Stop Bath
- Acetic Acid
- Lye

## **Solvents**

- EEI will pour out as many compatible flammable solvents as they receive. Which are typically: Gasoline, Kerosene, Lamp Fluid, & Automotive Fluids.

## **Motor Oil**

- All types of oils (exception being PCB Oils) will be bulked on-site.

## **Pesticides/Herbicides**

- In either liquid or solid form EEI will collect and dispose of Pesticide/Herbicide/Insecticide materials. These materials typically include: Lawn Fertilizers, Lawn Foods, Lawn Treatments, Plant Foods, Insecticides, & Rodent Poisons and Killers.

## **Propane**

- 20# Gas Grill Type
  - 1# Soldering/Small Stove Type
  - Larger Propane Tanks  
(On a case by case basis)
- (Must be manufacturer labeled as propane)

## **Reactives**

- Aluminum Paint
- Flammable Solids
- Dangerous when Wet Materials

## **Fluorescent Bulbs**

- 4' and 8' Bulbs (Unbroken)
- Compact Fluorescent Lamps—CFL

## **PCB Materials-**

### **Polychlorinated Biphenyls**

- Light Ballasts
- Capacitors
- Free-Liquid Oils (Must be marked as such)

## **Paint**

- EEI accepts both Oil Based and Latex Paint

## **Aerosol Cans**

- Any and all types of Aerosol Cans are accepted and recycled by EEI.
