

The Kentucky Residential Code has been updated to include revisions recently approved through the legislative review process. As with all amendments, a single line will appear in the margin of each code section to depict a modification since the 2007 Kentucky Residential Code went into effect on July 13, 2007. At the end of each amended section is language to identify when the amendment went into effect and the mandatory enforcement date.

The amendments recently approved and incorporated into the 2007 Kentucky Residential Code are as follows:

- Chapter 5 Section 502.2.2 by creating new subsections and Table to Section 502.2.2 dealing with deck construction. This new section was effective 1/06/2012 with mandatory enforcement beginning March 6, 2012.
- Amend Chapter 11 Energy Efficiency by amending the chapter to address compliance to be based on the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code and creating an exception for foundation wall energy code application. This amendment was effective 01/06/2012 with mandatory enforcement beginning October 1, 2012.
- Amend Chapter 43 to make reference to the 2009 International Energy Conservation Code rather than the 2006 International Energy Conservation Code. This amendment was effective 01/06/2012 with mandatory enforcement beginning October 1, 2012.
- Amend Chapter 43 to make reference to the 2011 NEC rather than the 2008 NEC. This amendment was effective 01/06/2012 with mandatory enforcement beginning March 6, 2012.
